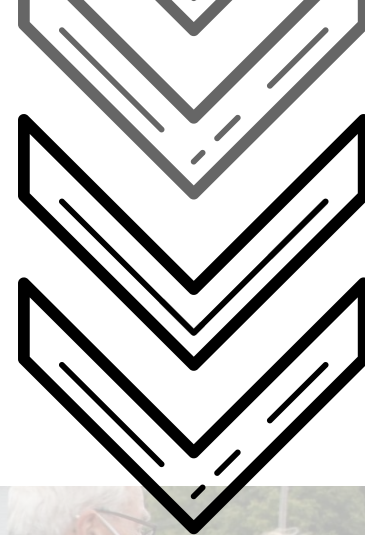

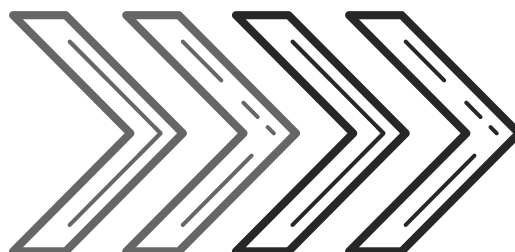
We're excited to offer the opportunity for Volunteer Expo attendees to help the Volunteer Center gift \$1,000 to a participating organization!

Here is how it will work:

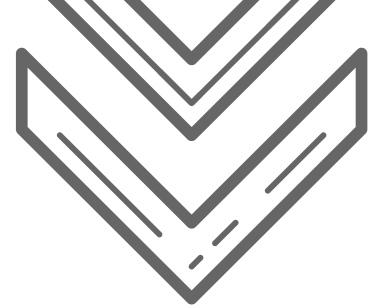
1. On Friday, September 18 at 6PM CST, the Volunteer Center will release a link to a Doodle poll via our Facebook event.

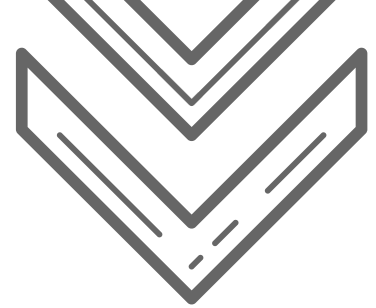

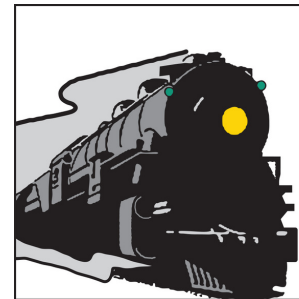
